BELOVED ELDER, FLOYD M. HAYES PASSES TO HIS REWARD

He was a staunch supporter of the Memphis School of Preaching, and quite often expressed his appreciation for the work of the School, and his hope for its future. He was a great encourager. His heart-felt words of compassion and commendation meant so much, and he seemed to know just when such was needed.

Men like Floyd M. Hayes are rare. We are thankful to have known him, and to have benefitted from his wise leadership and loving friendship.

We are going to miss him greatly, but we trust in hope that one day we shall be reunited.

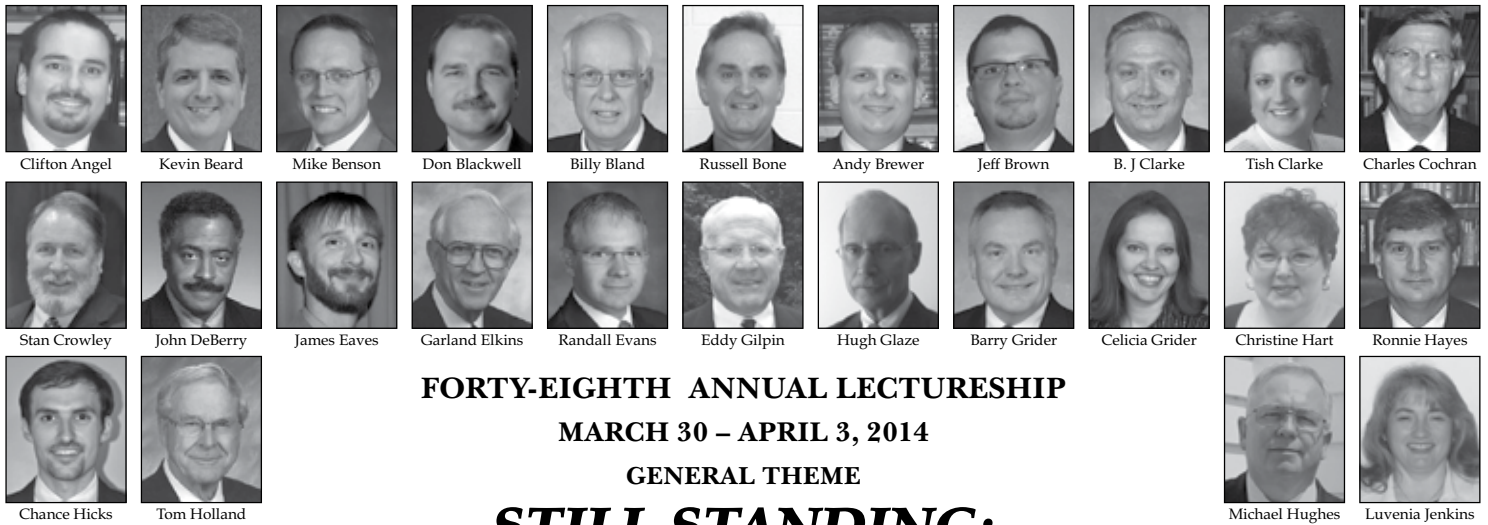
