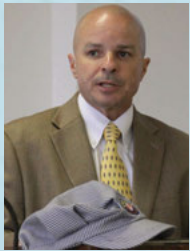

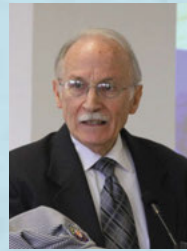

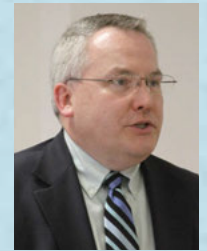

CENTER FOR THE STUDY OF ALCOHOL AND BIBLE WINES

Around four years ago a program was established at the Memphis School of Preaching which program would be focused upon guided research in the area of the history and dangers of alcohol. **Victor Durrington**, a stern opponent of the use and abuse of alcohol, posthumously was benefactor of the scholarship. Two brethren have fulfilled their requirements toward receiving this scholarship: **Gordon Wells**, who studied and reported on social drinking, and **Lee Snow**, who studied and reported on the use of alcohol/wine in religious services, both in the past and in modern day. Their studies were quite informative and beneficial for them and for the program.

This year, the **Center for the Study of Alcohol and Bible Wines** has selected **Michael Collins**, a second-year student, as recipient of the scholarship. Brother Collins is currently studying organizations (like Mothers Against Drunk Driving, Alcoholics Anonymous, et al) and their relationship to the field. He was a perfect candidate for the study having tragically lost a very close uncle to a drunk driver. From his progress thus far, it is evident that he has dedicated himself to the study.
