

FROM DREAMS TO REALITIES Garland Elkins

More than a decade ago the elders of the Knight Arnold Church of Christ wisely decided that the congregation, and one of the church's chief and most important works, the Memphis School of Preaching, should be moved to Forest Hill Irene Road, which is now incorporated into Germantown. That was a challenging move, but one that has been signally blessed by the Lord through His providence, and the generous assistance of numerous faithful congregations and Christians.

I very distinctly rememberthe day brother Curtis A. Cates, who was then Director of the Memphis School of Preaching, requested that brother Bobby Liddell (who is now Director of MSOP, and is doing an excellent job) and I should work together in raising the needed funds that we might build the necessary buildings on our new site. Brethren Cates and Liddell asked what I would suggest for use as a theme in raising the funds.

I suggested the following Scripture, which was spoken by the Lord to Israel as He promised that they would be restored to their homeland, and prosper: He said among otherthings they: "shall yet again take root downward, and bear fruit upward" (2 Kings 19:30).

Brother Cates asked that brother Liddell be responsible for the promotional and advertising part of the campaign, and that I be in charge of raising the money. Through the providence of the Lord and the help of faithful brethren, we were able to raise the money to build the MSOP school building. The church also built a commodious auditorium and an all-purpose building.

Some years later; the N. B. Hardeman library building was built, due in large measure to the generosity of brother Hardeman's family, though we were blessed to raise more than one-half million dollars toward that project. We truly are grateful to all who prayed for us and assisted monetarily

A GREAT NEED MET: NEW APARTMENTS FOR OUR STUDENTS

The elders bought ten acres of ground on which we built all of our original buildings. However, we still had a problem. We paid approximately \$23,000 each month; \$276,000 per year for rent of apartments for our students. The elders had an option to buy five additional acres of land, which adjoined our property. Brother Curtis Cates and I approached the elders with the suggestion that if they would approve it, brother Cates and I would raise money to buy the five additional acres of land on which to build our own apartments for our students. Through the providence of God and generosity of good brethren, we were successful in raising the money with which to pay for the five additional acres of land!

The land is debt free. The apartments are built and our students now live in them. The cost to build the apartments has been 3.5 million dollars. Through the grace of God and faithful congregations and individual Christians, we presently owe only \$900,000 on those new apartments. (Our *goal* is to raise this amount by the end of 2008, in order to be free of a monthly loan payment, and the interest such a loan requires. BL)
