Test on Chapters 10-16

Discussion Question: Select two of the following and write a one-two page answer. You may use your Bibles, but not personal notes.

- I. What is the value of Mark and his contribution to the biographical information on the life of Christ? Are there unique miracles that John records? What information does he provide that the other Gospels do not record? What about the purpose and the audience to whom he wrote?
- II. Give a defense of Mark 16:9-20 as a genuine part of Mark's inspired record
- III. Provide a summary of the events that occurred during the Passion week, beginning with His entry into Jerusalem, until His ascension into heaven. Lay out an argument for the day of the Lord's crucifixion. Touch on how Mark presents his record with regard to chronology.
- IV. Give an analysis of Mark 16:15-16 in defense of baptism as a part of the plan of salvation, bringing in other passages to support of whether or not baptism is essential. Provide a diagram of verse 16 showing relationship of baptism and faith to a person's salvation.
