REQUIREMENTS:

New Testament books from a lower criticism perspective and include therein at least five unique, original lessons gleaned from each book. Students taking the class for the M.O.S.T. Advanced Diploma must write a two page introduction for each with at least ten unique, original lessons.

Only students who are auditing are exempt from the introductions and final exam.
